

COM 2030 Script Writing 1 1 credit

Students will write basic scripts for a variety of media.

Objectives:

Students will become familiar with simple scripts.

They will:

- identify the characteristics of a good script
- write simple scripts for various A/V projects
- Write a complete script for a video which is actually filmed. The script will include a synopsis, storyboard, camera directions, prop list, and other special instructions necessary for filming and editing.

Teaching will take the form of guidance and direction. Use of exemplars (from previous classes) will also guide students.

Evaluation:

The evaluation is results-based. The final mark for the module will be based on a script for a video project selected and completed by the students that demonstrates an understanding of the concepts described above.

The script must match the video as filmed and edited, and must include synopsis, storyboard, camera directions, prop list, and other special instructions necessary for filming and editing.
