- 1.Canadian Voices
- 2.Novel study (Night by Elie Weisel)
- 3.School and Education (Dead Poets Society)
- 4.Macbeth

Each unit will have a mark break down and be worth 35 % of the final grade. There will be a final exam to make up the remaining 30%.
