This year we will be working on these strands through the following units and novel studies:

- 1.Charlotte’s Web
- 2.Fantasy, Make believe and Magic – Harry Potter
- 3.Glimpses of Other Worlds – The Lion, the Witch, and the Wardrobe

Through these units we will explore literature, writing skills, speaking skills, spelling, vocabulary, grammar, and listening skills.

There will be four reporting periods in which the students will receive progress reports. The reports will be based on work they do both in and out of class in the following areas:
