

Art 20 Long Range Plans

The art 20 course will continue students' exploration of art styles and media, beginning with a thorough review of pencil sketching techniques.

We will explore, through lessons, assignments and projects:

- Elements of design
- Control of space and form
- Texture and shadow
- Perspective
- Composition: both traditional and nontraditional
- Emotional impact of art works
- Colour: complementary colours, tone, shades, tints
- Using techniques above to convey a mood
- Art history
- Architecture
- Clay sculpture

Students will become more confident in their drawing, and will use techniques they have learned in class or in a previous course to improve their work. Students will also learn and use correct art terminology to critique their work and the work of others.

Students will not only become familiar with different artists throughout history, but will also become aware of different styles and periods.

Students taking this course for 5 credits will cover individual concepts in more depth, with extra lessons and assignments.
